To support the Corporate Accountability Campaign to protect the public by helping corporate or federal government whistleblowers expose corporate wrongdoing and/or undue influence on drug and food safety, environmental, and worker and public health concerns. The Campaign will continue to provide public education about the 2002 whistleblower protections of the Sarbanes-Oxley Act and advance the success of those reforms through both test cases and negotiations with corporations that are prepared to address whistleblower disclosures in good faith. In support of these efforts, the Campaign also will investigate substantive allegations of wrongdoing exposed by whistleblowers and advocate for reforms that flow from their critical insider information.
