Organizational Capacity Building will enable IKAR to further explore the sustainability and success of this model through a strategic planning process. IKAR will develop a short-term strategic plan for the initial years of IKAR's organizational operation, create a blueprint that will aid in setting organizational goals, institute an annual planning process, develop a fundraising strategy and plan, and create an overall plan for organizational growth. It will also begin implementation of the strategic plan.
